

## Good Shepherd Academy Academic Probation Policy

Academic probation is determined by the Administration. A student may be placed on academic probation when the student demonstrates a need for additional tutoring or academic support, his or her grade point average is lower than 2.0 at any given time, he or she receives more than five incompletes per quarter, or the student is not passing a course for the quarter.

In addition, students who are new to GSA may be placed on academic probation if the above, or any other concern arises that may seem to indicate the student may struggle academically at GSA.

Possible interventions include additional study periods during the school day, tutoring, weekly check-ins, suspension from extra-curricular activities, and/or grade retention. Parents will be asked to sign assignment notebooks on a daily basis until the student is off of academic probation. The goal of these interventions is to see evidence of academic growth, not necessarily mastery of the content.
